Dr Colin Harbinson, International Director of StoneWorks, is based at Belhaven College in the USA, but will be in Adelaide to facilitate and teach at two StoneWorks conferences in January 2009. Tabor Adelaide has partnered with StoneWorks to provide support and sponsorship for the inaugural Summit and StoneWorks Arts Leadership Training (SALT) events.

The Summit will run from 12-15 January 2009, at Tabor Adelaide. This event draws together around 40 established arts leaders and gatekeepers, from the domains of the church, missions, marketplace and academies, for dialogue, prayer and discovery of pathways leading to church and cultural renewal -and to network and discuss strategies for ongoing national initiatives.

The StoneWorks Arts Leadership Training (SALT) conference will run 19-22 Jan 2009. This is a larger gathering of around 80-90 invited leaders, or emerging arts leaders, who have been identified as strategic in their field of the church, missions, marketplace and/ or education. They will be encouraged and mentored to be morally, intellectually and spiritually transformational leaders- faithful to the call to be 'salt' in their particular cultural context.
